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Biden Leads by 10% & Peters Leads by 9% *(Biden 52% - Trump 42%/Peters 52% - James 43%)*

EAST LANSING, Mich. — Former Vice President Joe Biden (52%) continues to have a ten percent lead over President Donald Trump (42%) in Michigan while US Senator Gary Peters (52%) has increased his six percent lead to nine percent over challenger John James (43%) in the race for the US Senate according to a poll conducted by Mitchell Research Communications of likely voters in the upcoming November 3rd Election.

The poll, commissioned by MIRS, a Lansing based publication, used a combination of IVR (automated) surveys as well as text message polling to cell phones of those under the age of 45. The survey (**WHICH SHOULD BE REFERRED TO AS THE MIRS/MITCHELL POLL**) of N=759 Likely Voters was conducted October 25-27, 2020 has a Margin of Error of + or – 3.56% at the 95% level of confidence.

“Joe Biden continues to have a ten percent lead over President Trump a week after our last survey. Biden is getting 98% of the Democratic vote, up 3% since last week, while Trump has increased his share of the GOP vote from 89% to 91%. Biden has lengthened his lead among independents from 54%-27% to 59%-18%. Trump’s two percent lead with men (47%-45%) isn’t nearly enough to overcome Biden’s twenty-one percent lead (59%-38%) with women. Trump is running out of time if he is going to win Michigan,” Steve Mitchell, president of Mitchell Research said

Eighty-four percent said they watched the last presidential debate. Five percent said the debate made them change to Biden and eighteen percent said it helped them to finally decide for Biden. Two percent said it made them change to Trump while fifteen percent made them decide for Trump.

In terms of issues,

- Thirty-three percent (up from 30% in the last poll) said Jobs/Economy is the most important issue in their choice for president and Trump has a huge 73%-19% lead with voters who cite the issue. It was 79%-16% last week.
- The coronavirus (20%) is second and Biden leads by a whopping 97%-2, up from an 88%-10% margin last week.
- Law & Order (17%) is next, where Trump has a whopping 92%-2% lead, up from 72%-19%.
- Healthcare (12%) is fourth and Biden leads by a strong 87%-6% margin, up from 82%-8% margin.

About 47% approve of the job Trump is doing, up from 44%, while Governor Whitmer's job approval moved up from 57% to 60%.

"Currently, Biden seems to be in command in Michigan and John James is now polling about the same as Trump."

[The MIRS/Mitchell Poll was conducted by Mitchell Research and Communications of East Lansing, MI and was commissioned by MIRS. Mitchell Research's final poll in the 2020 Democratic Primary was the most accurate poll conducted by a Michigan pollster and the second most accurate of the seven polls conducted prior to the election]
