MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE
ON
GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS

Tuesday, March 12, 2019 9:00 a.m. Room 308, House Office Building

The House Committee on Government Operations was called to order by the Chairman, Representative Jason Sheppard.

HB 4009 (Rep. Lasinski) Civil rights; other; separation of material exempt from disclosure; provide for.

HB 4010 (Rep. Glenn) Civil rights; other; appeal procedure of the legislative open records act (LORA); provide for.

HB 4011 (Rep. Berman) Civil rights; other; legislative open records act (LORA); create as part of the freedom of information act.

HB 4012 (Rep. Hauck) Public employees and officers; state; designation of legislative open records act (LORA) coordinator; provide for.

HB 4013 (Rep. Allor) Civil rights; other; fee for public record search under legislative open records act (LORA); provide for.

HB 4014 (Rep. Schroeder) Civil rights; other; access to public record search under legislative open records act (LORA); provide for.

HB 4015 (Rep. Filler) Civil rights; other; disclosure of certain legislative open records; provide exemption.

HB 4016 (Rep. Camilleri) Legislature; legislative agencies; deciding appeals of public records requests under the legislative open records act (LORA); add to legislative council administrator's duties.

The Chair gave remarks pertaining to the proposed changes on the package of bills.

Jasmine Braun-Moreland, Legislative Affairs for Governor Gretchen Whitmer, submitted a card in support of the bill, and stated that the Governor maintains her belief in the importance of judicial review, but supports this package in the spirit of compromise.
