MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE
ON
WAYS AND MEANS

Thursday, April 18, 2019 10:30 a.m. Room 352, Capitol Building

The House Committee on Ways And Means was called to order by the Chairman, Representative Brandt Iden.

Members present: Representatives Iden, Lilly, Leutheuser, Griffin, Hauck, Kahle, Wentworth, Warren, Byrd, Neeley, and Hertel.

Members absent/excused: None.

The Chair introduced his constituents, Mr. John Beck, and his history class from Heritage Christian Academy.

Rep. Leutheuser, introduced his constituent, William Behrendt from Hillsdale, MI.

The Chair laid before the committee HB 4048 and HB 4049:

HB 4048 (Inman) Businesses; nonprofit corporations; merger or conversion into nonprofit corporations; authorize for summer resort and park associations.

HB 4049 (Inman) Businesses; associations; merger or conversion of summer resort and park association into nonprofit corporations; authorize.

Representative Marino, and Trey Hines, representing Representative Inman's office, introduced the bills to the committee. Questions and discussion followed.

The Chair went at ease at 10:41 a.m., and reconvened at 10:42 a.m.

The Chair laid before the committee HB 4152 and HB 4153:

HB 4152 (S. Johnson) Records; birth; fees and procedure to obtain birth certificate; modify for certain individuals.

HB 4153 (Guerra) Records; birth; definition of certain individuals eligible for different fees and procedure to obtain birth certificate; provide for.

Representative Steven Johnson, and Representative Guerra, introduced the bills to the committee. Questions and discussion followed.

Representative Warren moved to adopt the substitute (H-2) to HB 4152.

The motion prevailed by a vote of 11-0-0.
