## COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

**May 9, 2019**

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 1:02 p.m. He instructed the Clerk to call the roll. At that time, the following members were present: Chairman VanderWall, Sen.(s) Bizon, Johnson, LaSata, MacDonald, Theis, Brinks, Hertel, Santana, and Wojno, a quorum was present.
