MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE
ON
TAX POLICY

Wednesday, May 22, 2019 10:30 a.m. Room 521 House Office Building

The House Standing Committee on Tax Policy was called to order by the Chair.

Chair Afendoulis requested attendance be called to establish a quorum of the appointed committee members:

Representative Vaupel moved to adopt the minutes from the May 15th, 2019, meeting. There being no objection, the motion was approved by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid before the committee the following presentation:

House Fiscal Agency, regarding the Wayfair decision.

Jim Stansell, representing the House Fiscal Agency, presented to the committee.

The Chair laid the following bills before the committee:

- HB 4540 (Rep. Afendoulis) Sales tax; other; nexus of marketplace facilitators; clarify.
- HB 4541 (Rep. Tate) Use tax; other; nexus of marketplace facilitators; clarify.
- HB 4542 (Rep. Webber) Sales tax; collections; out-of-state retailers; require to remit sales tax.
- HB 4543 (Rep. Yancey) Use tax; collections; out-of-state retailers; require to remit use tax.

The Chair went at ease and handed the gavel over to Vice Chair Lower at 10:48 a.m.

Vice Chair Lower called the committee to order at 10:49 a.m.

Representative Afendoulis, Representative Webber, Representative Yancey, and Representative Tate spoke in support of the bills. Questions and discussion followed.
