MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE
ON
GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS

Tuesday, June 3, 2019 9:00 a.m. Room 308, House Office Building

The House Committee on Government Operations was called to order by the Chairman, Representative Jason Sheppard.

Members present: Representatives Sheppard, Cole, Lilly, and Rabbi
Members absent/excused: Rep. Greig

Representative Lilly moved to adopt the May 1st, 2019, minutes. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid SB 200, SB 282, and SB 283 before the committee:

SB 200(Sen. Wojno) Health; other; opioid antagonists; allow prescribers to prescribe and pharmacists to dispense to public libraries under certain circumstances.

SB 282(Sen. VanderWall) Health facilities; emergency medical services; protocol related to the use of opioid antagonists by life support agencies and emergency medical services personnel; remove.

SB 283(Sen. Lucido) Education; school districts; authority of school districts and school employees to administer opioid antagonists in the revised school code; repeal.
Senator Wojno and Kristin Shelley, representing the Michigan Library Association, testified in support of the bills.

Caroline Leithen, representing the Michigan Department of Education, submitted a card in support of SB 200, but did not wish to speak.

Patrick Tiedt, representing Senator VanderWall, submitted a card in support of SB 282, and was available to answer any questions.

Scott Ray, representing Senator Lucido, submitted a card in support of SB 283, and was available to answer any questions.

Representative Rabbi moved to report SB 200 with recommendation. The motion prevailed 4-0-0.
