The House Committee on Ways And Means was called to order by the Chairman, Representative Brandt Iden.

The Chair laid before the committee SB 192 and SB 193:

SB 192    (Victory)                      Vehicles; driver training; waiver of night driving requirement for individuals holding a graduated driver license; provide for under certain conditions.

SB 193    (Victory)                      Vehicles; driver training; waiver of night driving requirement for a segment 2 curriculum course; provide for under certain conditions.

Representative Lilly moved to report SB 192 with recommendation.
