Representative Hertel moved to adopt the minutes from the Tuesday, June 11, 2019 meeting.

The Chair laid before the committee HB 4223:

HB 4223 (VanSingel)      Health; screening; dental screening of children; require.

Representative Hauck moved to adopt the substitute (H-1) to HB 4223.

The Chair laid before the committee SB 129:

SB 129 (Schmidt) Aeronautics; unmanned aircraft systems; local ordinances; allow a political subdivision to regulate unmanned aircraft systems in certain circumstances.

Representative Lilly moved to adopt the substitute (H-3) to SB 129.

The motion prevailed by a vote of 11-0-0.
