Representative O'Malley, Chair, called the meeting to order.

Representative Sheppard made a motion to adopt the minutes of the meeting held on June 11, 2019. No objections being offered, the minutes were accepted as presented.

The Chair laid HB 4081 before the committee.

HB 4081 (Rep. Kennedy) Highways; memorial; portion of M-57 in Genesee County; designate as the "Firefighter Mike Wager Memorial Highway".

Representative Kennedy, joined by Clio Area Fire Chief Kerry Paulson, testified in support of the bill.

Representative Sneller offered the following amendment to HB 4081:

1. Amend page 1, line 2, after "AT" by striking out "3400" and inserting "3291".

Representative Kennedy spoke to the amendment.

Representative Sneller moved to amend HB 4081. The motion prevailed 13-0-0.

HB 4628 (Rep. Shannon) Traffic control; violations; record of certain traffic violations; modify time for destruction.

Representative Shannon testified in support of the bill.
