MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE
ON
TAX POLICY

The House Standing Committee on Tax Policy was called to order by the Chair.

The Chair went at ease at 10:31 a.m.

The Chair called the committee back to order at 11:34 a.m.

HB 4541 (Rep. Tate) Use tax; other; nexus of marketplace facilitators; clarify.
HB 4542 (Rep. Webber) Sales tax; collections; out-of-state retailers; require to remit sales tax.
HB 4543 (Rep. Yancey) Use tax; collections; out-of-state retailers; require to remit use tax.
